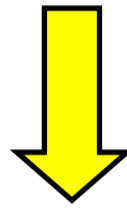


# Process Flow Chart A—Government Departments

The Political Party that has the majority will have a Party Policy (available on their web page) on things such as:

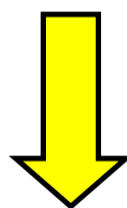
