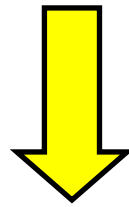


# Process Flow Chart B – Company Process

The Company wanting to undertake a project that involves access to government owned resources such as CSG, Coal will need to develop an application



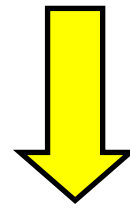
That application will go to the council for development approval, but the state will be involved for matters of state importance.

These applications may or may not require public notification or land owner approval.

Some projects of economic, social or environmental impact will need an Environmental Impact Statement which involves an evolutionary process from Terms of Reference through to the final product which may or may not require public review and comments.

It can be referred to a nationally based Independent Expert Scientific Committee who will advise on direct and cumulative effects of the project.

Which is then evaluated by the Coordinator General, and ultimately an Environmental Authority will be given which is administered and enforced by the Department of Environment and the Environmental Protection Act.



The specific way in which the company operates its business is administered and enforced through the Department of Natural Resources and Mines and the Petroleum and Gas (Production and Safety) Act.
